For those of you who attend the 11am Mass you may have noticed the prelude to the Mass sung by the college ensemble from Stetson University.

The "Regina Caeli" by Lotti

This is one of four Marian antiphons. It is sung throughout Eastertide. (That is, from Easter Day through Pentecost, the seventh Sunday after Easter.)

The Regina Caeli is also sung in place of the Angelus during Eastertide which is why we are singing it before Mass.

Below is the English translation. We are singing the Latin version below that at 11am.

R. For He whom you did merit to bear, alleluia.
V. Has risen, as he said, alleluia.
R. Pray for us to God, alleluia.
V. Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, alleluia.

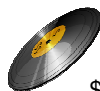
