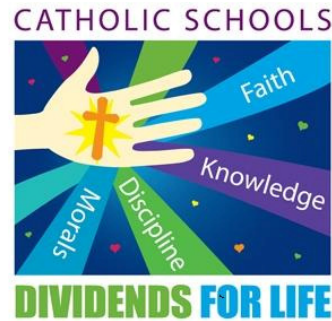
PRAYER CHALICE FOR VOCATIONS
