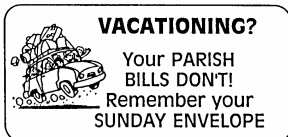

- Ability to stay focused and sing in front of a large congregation while following musical accompaniment.
- Maintain appropriate dress code, and appropriate ministerial behavior.
