MISSION CO-OP APPEAL

Next weekend, we welcome Fr. Joseph Pednekar, M.S.F.S., who will speak at all Masses about the mission work of the Church, especially the work of his own community – the Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales.

The Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales are sent directly by the Holy Father to a region where no Gospel has ever been preached before; or where there is not much Catholic presence. They are given 10 to 15 years to establish the diocese, after which they will have to hand over the diocese to the Diocesan Clergy and the Missionaries will be asked to evangelize another area. In 160 years in India alone, they have already established 24 dioceses.

Besides evangelization, the Missionaries are engaged in building churches, chapels, mission schools, technical and trade schools, orphanages, dispensaries, etc., as the situation in a new diocese demands. Every Mission has a mission school, an orphanage, a dispensary, where hundreds of poor people are given free medicine. Every mission too has a food distribution center, where the starving people are given food. Every year about 350-400 babies are given to them by desperate mothers, who want to see their children live. Once they are given to the Mission they have the obligation to feed them, clothe them, educate them and get them settled in life. They also have to maintain a number of Catechists who keep the faith alive in the absence of the Missionary.
