MUSIC MINISTRY NEWS

Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week and the end of Lent. The liturgical music that accompanies Holy Week can be heard throughout the world and the text and many cases melodies have remained intact for hundreds of years. One of the most compelling hymns of Holy Week is sung as the verse to the Gospel Acclamation on Palm Sunday; *"Christ became obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Because of this, God greatly exalted him and bestowed on him the name which is above every other name."* This acclamation is the ancient "Christus Factus Est" which is heard once again on Good Friday. In addition, as we venerate the cross on Good Friday we sing "The Reproaches" a compelling series of chants and responses which still maintains the greek Trisagion (most holy of hymns) *"Agios O Theos, Agios Ischryos, Agios Athanatos Eleison Imas"*, (Holy is God, Holy and Strong, Holy and Mighty have mercy on us.)

Finally we open Easter Vigil with the celebrated *Exsultet*, which will be presented by choir and chanters this year. Won't you walk with us this final week as we remember, give thanks and praise to the One, Jesus Christ, Savior of all mankind, who brought us salvation and redemption.
