**BECOME A MINISTER TO THE SICK**

Our parish is in need of Ministers to the Sick. Ministry to the Sick is a pastoral ministry of caring for those people hospitalized, in nursing homes, or confined to private homes. These ministers are trained and formed to conduct a pastoral visit with time to listen and pray about the concerns of the sick or shut-in person and to share Eucharist with them.

Ministry to the Sick certification is obtained after completion of one day basic Ministry to the Sick Training (6 hours) and the one day Eucharistic Ministry Training workshop (3 1/2 hours). If you are a Eucharistic Minister, you do not need to do this training.

The next training for Ministry to the Sick is scheduled for Saturday, May 15, 2010 at Epiphany Catholic Church in Port Orange.
