**BECOME A MINISTER TO THE SICK**

Our parish is in need of Ministers to the Sick. Ministry to the Sick is a pastoral ministry of caring for those people hospitalized, in nursing homes, or confined to private homes. These ministers are trained and formed to conduct a pastoral visit with time to listen and pray about the concerns of the sick or shut-in person and to share Eucharist with them.

Ministry to the Sick certification is obtained after completion of one day basic Ministry to the Sick Training (6 hours) and the one day Eucharistic Ministry Training workshop (31/2 hours). If you are a Eucharistic Minister, you do not need to do this training.

The next training for Ministry to the Sick is scheduled for Saturday, May 15, 2010 at Epiphany Catholic Church in Port Orange. Dear Parishioners,

Each year the Lilly Endowment, Inc. provides resources for a National Clergy Renewal Program. The grant is given for pastors and parishes to engage in a period of renewal. I am pleased to announce that the application submitted by our Pastoral Council was accepted and a grant was awarded. The grant will provide funds for a three month sabbatical for me and an opportunity for parish ministry renewal and reflection.

I will begin the sabbatical on May 24, 2010. I will be going on a 30 day retreat at the Loyola Retreat Center in Faulkner, Maryland and at the St. Benedict Monastery in Bristow, Virginia. After the retreat I will tour the Basilicas of Bavaria and attend the Passion Play in Oberammergau, Germany which is performed only every 10 years. After some time with my family back in Maryland, I will be attending a language school in Quito, Ecuador to work on my Spanish language skills.

While I am away, Fr. Tom McMackin will cover for me for six weeks. After July 4<sup>th</sup>, Fr. Jememiah Payne will return from Rome to serve at the Basilica of St. Paul until mid-August. Fr. Jeremiah will be conducting workshops for parish ministries and parish renewal. I will return on August 15<sup>th</sup> and after my return, I will be presenting information and highlights of the Basilicas I visited in Bavaria.

The Lilly Endowment grant suggested that the parish celebrate the pastor's leaving with a congregational event. Therefore, the Annual Parish Picnic will serve as a send off for my sabbatical leave. I am grateful to the Lord for this time away for renewal. I thank Archbishop-designate Wenski for his approval of my leave. Please keep me in your prayers while I'm away as I will pray for each of you during the sabbatical. God bless you all and I'll see you at the Parish Picnic on Sunday May 23, 2010.
